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**Job Description:**

The Senior Patrol Leader is elected by the Scouts to represent them as the top junior leader in the troop. He first serves a six month term as an Assistant Senior Patrol Leader.

The Scout will be expected to complete a "Self Assessment" form and present it at the Scoutmaster Conference upon conclusion of this positions term.*

**Qualifications for the Senior Patrol Leader Position:**

- Be age 14
- Star Rank or higher
- Demonstrated outstanding leadership skills
- Served successfully for one term as Assistant Senior Patrol Leader
- Be a member of the Boy Scouts for at least one year
- Must have completed or are planning on attending Troop Leadership Training
- Must have actively participated in short and long term camping with the Troop
